## ESP Quick Tip #42: Display Virtual Samples on Your Website



To display virtual sample images for products on an ESP Website or Company Store, log into ESP Web and click on the Websites Admin tab. Locate the ESP Website or Company Store with which you would like to work and click on the Edit Site button.



Then, take the following steps:

1. Expand the Manage Products section and click on Virtual Samples.



2. Select the "I want to show a Virtual Sample ready product image using an image that I selected" option.

click on the "Select from Image Library" option to open the Media Manager.
